## MAINTENANCE AND INSTALLATION OF STREET POLE BANNERS WESTSIDE BUSINESS DISTRICTS – GRAND RAPIDS, MI

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Westside Corridor Improvement Authority (CIA), in partnership with the City of Grand Rapids, is seeking proposals from qualified vendors to provide maintenance and installation services for street pole banners in the Westside Business Districts. The service areas include Stockbridge (Stocking & Bridge), West Leonard (including Seward), West Fulton, and Butterworth Business Corridors.

#### 2. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The selected vendor will be responsible for the following:

#### i. Installation of Banners

- Install banners on designated street poles throughout the business districts.
- Secure banners using appropriate mounting hardware to ensure safety and durability.
- A banner is described as a sign that attaches to a pole between 8-15 feet in the air.

#### ii. Maintenance Services

- Perform routine inspections to ensure banners remain in good condition, at a minimum every 90 days.
- Replace or re-secure loose, damaged, or missing banners as needed. Once vandalism
  or damage is reported, the vendor has 15 business days to replace and/or restore the
  banner.
- All requests for banner take-down and installation will be in writing, and after permits are
  approved, the vendor will have 4 weeks to install the signage. If the installation were to
  happen at an extremely busy time of the year, the vendor will communicate with the CIA
  so that no rush fees are incurred to save taxpayer dollars. (unless the CIA authorizes a
  rush)

#### iii. Removal

Remove banners at the end of their display period.



• The vendor will promptly remove signage/banners when instructed to take down.

## iv. Compliance with City Regulations

- Ensure all installations comply with the City of Grand Rapids' ordinances and safety standards.
- Coordinate with the City for any necessary permits or approvals.

#### 3. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Interested vendors must submit a proposal that includes:

## i. Company Information

- Name, address, and contact details.
- Overview of the company, including relevant experience.

#### ii. Work Plan & Methodology

- Description of the installation and maintenance approach.
- Proposed schedule for banner installation and maintenance cycles.
- Marketing ideas for the placement of banners. i.e., there are 243 current banner locations on the Westside, should we utilize every pole or every other pole.

#### iii. Project Budget

Detailed cost breakdown

#### iv. Experience & References

- Examples of similar projects completed.
- At least three references from past clients.

## v. Insurance & Licensing

- Proof of liability insurance and worker's compensation coverage.
- Any necessary licenses to operate in Grand Rapids, MI.

#### vi. Registered Vendor

• Register as a vendor with the City of Grand Rapids

#### 4. SELECTION CRITERIA

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Experience and qualifications (30%)
- Proposed methodology and timeline (25%)
- Cost-effectiveness (20%)
- References and past performance (15%)
- Compliance with city regulations (10%)

#### 5. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

All proposals must be submitted no later than **5:00 pm** EST on Friday, **September 26th, 2025**. Responses should be delivered electronically to **econdevshrd@grcity.us**.
