## **Spartan Innovations**

- Sponsorship from local businesses
  - \$37k committed statewide for programming and operations.
- Grants Submitted
  - Nearly \$13 million to support/grow operations in GR focused on tech development, linking SmartZone initiatives, DEI in tech entrepreneurship, and making GR a health tech center.
  - Over \$220 million under consideration to grow operations statewide for tech corridor initiative (GR to Detroit pipeline).
- Grants in Progress
  - Roughly \$90 million to support statewide efforts in tech, health tech, and fin/insurance tech.


